### Key vocabulary

Architecture	The art of designing and construction buildings.
Frida Kahlo	An influential Mexican artist pivotal to the art of South America.
Latin American Art	Latin American art refers to the artistic expression of South America, Central America, the Caribbean and Mexico.
Self-portrait	A representation of an artist drawn, painted or sculpted by that artist.
Surrealism	A movement in art and literature aimed at expressing imaginative dreams and visions.
Symmetry	This refers to when the elements of a painting or a drawing balance each other out.
